Multiple District 37 and MDC Hall Of Fame

Hall of Fame

In 1986 the Council of Governors of our Multiple District established the Lions Hall of Fame. Since that time many distinguished members of our Lions Family have been inducted into its ranks. Each of those inductees have made an extraordinary contribution to our progress as a Multiple District of Lions Clubs International. Each of those inductees has made a great contribution to their club and to their community. In many ways, each of those inductees are “model” Lions and “model” citizens of either Canada or the United States of America.

Up until 2002 the selection of nominees was made by the outgoing Council of Governors. It is now done by the delegates of the nominee’s home District at their annual District Convention. Any Lion, Lioness, Lions Club, Lioness Club, Zone or Region may nominate a candidate from their District to the Hall of Fame. There is no nomination fee. There may be a maximum of one candidate per District inducted into the Hall of Fame each year. If more than one in each District, the candidate receiving 50 % plus one vote will be declared the winner. He or she will be inducted into the Hall of Fame. In 2017 this was changed to a maximum of two candidates per District inducted into the Hall of Fame in each year. If more than two in each District, the two candidates receiving the most delegates votes are declared the winners. The Cabinet Secretary must receive nominations at least 45 days prior to the District Annual Convention. The nomination may be for either a Lion or a Lioness, and it may be awarded posthumously. Each candidate must have at least 15 years of service and not be a member of the current Council of Governors.

The nominee should have qualifications above and beyond the call of duty including social and human endeavours. He or she should be of good moral character and have a good reputation in his or her community.
